Bible Class Lesson Seven:

GROWING YOUR SPIRIT SOUL

Chapter One Emotion vs. Spirit

Key Scripture:

"<u>I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending</u>, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty." Revelation 1:8 (Rev. 1:11; 21:6; 22:13)

"For this is <u>the love of God, that we keep his commandments</u>: and his commandments are not grievous." 1 John 5:3

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that <u>whosoever believeth in him</u> should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16

Lesson Objective:

To enhance our spiritual growth by moving us from our physical natures and move us towards our spiritual natures. <u>By moving us away from one</u> of the top physical natures we experience—pleasure through our emotional natures, we can experience true love. To move the reader's awareness into a state of seeking the divine nature of Christ. We must seek the attributes of Christ Jesus in us, which will allow us to move in the miracles of Christ. Lesson:

Emotion vs. Spirit

Here is a mystery revealed: Alpha and Omega, Christ Jesus: the beginning and the end. The antichrist has taught us the end first. Jesus is Love. And He is. However, this is the beginning. Hear this! God is Love. Love is God (on the inside), not an emotion! Hint: God is love, God is spirit, and Spirit is action.

Here it is. Bless your eyes and ears to receive this Heavenly Manna. Check out these Scriptures: 1) **Revelation 1:8**—the action is He started it and He finished it; 2) **1 John 5:3**—the action is living a life like Jesus; 3) **John 3:16**—the action is God sent His Son and His Son lived a sinfree life for you and me. <u>Love is action</u>.

When you say (or think), "God is love"; you attempt to place a multiple universe-sized Being in a word or a feeling or an "emotion," or a bio-chemical reaction. When you say (or think), "Love is God," now you are fitting or placing an emotion, a bio-chemical reaction, a feeling under the auspices, dominion of our Heavenly Father (FTHR). We think of how much love He has for us that He gave His only Begotten Son (John 3:16) and how He will accept anyone and everyone, just where they are in their lives with their "stinking thinking" and their "stinking living." Christ Jesus—Everlasting Father—cleans us up!
