Worship in Spirit and in Truth. Part Two. (CONTINUING) One can barely hear the teachings of The Messiah when listening to mainstream Christian radio or television. Christ. Christians. We follow the Teachings of The Messiah. "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ." John 1:17 Many preachers are preaching from the Old Testament. I do not have anything against the Old Testament, though it holds very few of the Teachings of The Messiah. Those passages which Jesus saw fit to bring from the Old Testament to the New Testament, He brought forward.
