This devotional is to give you a better idea of who I am from questions posed to me yesterday by <u>Pastor Ravi in Pakistan</u>. These questions were for a specific project on which he is working. Read on and be blessed and refreshed in the Lord.

I have read the Bible through three times and I am doing my fourth reading now, but this time, it is after the Archangel Gabriel laid his hands on me and delivered me from a crack cocaine addiction. Gabriel was there with Jesus and my grandmother. I have not been the same since that night. I can now see between the lines of the Holy Scriptures when I read them as illuminated by the Holy Spirit and other Holy Family members. The Holy Spirit told me how to hear the Lord. And it took me about two years to learn how to hear the different voices of our Holy Family. Instead of saying, "Something told me." Or "I came up with this idea." Or "I did this or that." I learned to give honor and recognition to the Angels, to my Guardian Angel, to the Holy Spirit, to Jesus, to our Heavenly Father, to Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge and a host of other Holy Family members as outlined in the Holy Scriptures.

I had to deal with family, friends, and acquaintances who would tell me, "That was your idea." Or "You came up with the name eBlessings." When I told them that the Holy Spirit told me that name. "You did it on your own." Is what people would say. And this list can go on and on as people would say to me, "Don't talk so much about demons and devils." As if they do not exist. How can a Christian not talk about the evil that abounds on this earth and not recognize the Holy Scriptures:

Ephesians 6:12—"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."

Here are some of the questions:

- 1. Who is God? Your Father. Your spiritual Father. The Creator of the universe.
- 2. Where did He come from? He always existed. You could say that He came from Himself... smile. He is Alpha and Omega. "I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty." - What do you know about sin? Sin is evil; evil thoughts, words, and deeds, etc. Get more specific. Where did evil come? Evil came from satan... pride and rebellion.
- 6. When did sin begin? The exact time is unknown, except it happened when satan was filled with pride and rebelled against our Father. "12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit." Isaiah 14:12-15
