*I was telling a sister the other day, "I have not seen so many Christians who have the Holy Ghost, never hear the Holy Ghost speaking to them."*

**"But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." John 14:26**

**"But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost." Mark 13:11**

**P****eople with the Holy Ghost.** Father God thank You for blessing the reader spiritually so they can walk victoriously in the worldliness, covetousness, idolatry, and ungodliness with which they are confronted. In Emmanuel's name, I ask You and thank You Father for that. Amen.

I was telling a Sister friend the other day that I cannot believe how many Christians claim to have the Holy Spirit but do not hear from the Holy Spirit. In other words, do not hear the voice of the Holy Spirit but look for the Comforter speaking to them in situations and life's circumstances. What is that about? Who has lied to you and told you that you cannot hear the Holy Spirit speak to you? Some highly educated person wrapped in the spirit of the Pharisee, wrapped in the old covenant and not listening to and adhering to the New Covenant, i.e., Christ Jesus. **"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Acts 2:38** So Christians believe they have the Holy Ghost once saved. Listen, they as I, do believe that the Holy Ghost is living inside of them, inside of me, and inside of you. But

Brothers and Sisters, if the Holy Ghost, the Holy Spirit is living in you, why can you not hear the Holy Spirit speaking to you? When you have a spiritual question, why can you not hear the Holy Ghost answering you? Is it because worldliness and covetousness is blocking your spirit and your ears from hearing the Comforter? If something is blocking you from hearing, then could something be blocking you from seeing life's circumstances and situations from the view that the Holy Spirit would give to you to give you directions? Oh, this entire question gets deeper still and worse still.

Listen. If you ask most Christians they will tell you that they have Jesus living inside of them. If the person is a born-again Christian, they will surely say they have Jesus living inside of them. Now let me give you this example. If you are married and your spouse somehow got inside of you— Let's say you have a best friend and they somehow got inside of you— Let's say your boss or co-worker got inside of you—could you imagine that they would be quiet all the time? Or could you imagine that they would be attempting to speak to you quite a bit about all types of things? That is a little like what I am attempting to get you to understand.

Let's say that Jesus is inside of you and the Holy Spirit is inside of you. Then why in the name of Christ Jesus can you not hear Him speaking to you? Do you think for a second that Jesus would get inside of you and not talk to you about all the wonders of Heaven and all the mysteries of His Kingdom. Or talk about how to defeat evil which is presently reigning upon the earth and appearing to strengthen its stranglehold on humanity. Christians do not believe they can do what Jesus did and more, even after He told us that we could. Huh?
