God is asking: Where are you now?

**And the Lord called unto Adam, and said unto him, where art thou?
And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because
I was naked; and I hid myself.**

GENESIS 3:9-10 (KJV)

In Genesis, the Bible talks about the first man and woman (Adam and Eve) and their first sin due to temptation. When satan (the snake) had managed to deceive the woman, her husband, Adam, was faced with a situation of disobedience and shame. He had an opportunity to make a good choice. He made a decision, which was a poor one. In fact, he made several decisions which were not the best. He decided to hide as he realized he was naked and that he was wrong in what he had done.

We remember that God asked him, "Where are you?" (**Genesis 9**) Adam replied, "I heard your voice in the garden and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself." Then God asked again, "Who told you that you are naked? Have you eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded you that you should not eat?" Adam replied, "The woman whom you gave me to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat."

In fact all these responses are not straightforward. Adam should have immediately accepted responsibility and said, "I am here, oh God forgive me because I have eaten of the forbidden tree." In our daily life we should avoid evasive responses. God is asking every one of us, "Where are you?" You may return to Jesus and receive Him as your Savior in your life. God doesn't dislike the sinners but hates the sins. God loves you and accepts you as you are.
